

**Transfer Agreement between  
Santa Rosa Junior College and the  
Southern Vermont College Division of Nursing**

Students may enter the Bachelor of Science in Nursing program as their route to initial licensure or may complete the BSN degree as a licensed RN.

If a student has already completed the Associate's Degree in Nursing at Santa Rosa Junior College and has passed the NCLEX licensing exam, then the student is required to have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 and must present the RN license to enter the BSN program at Southern Vermont College. A student must complete the degree requirements for the ADN and an additional 51 credits to complete the BSN degree. A minimum of 39 of the 51 credits must be taken at Southern Vermont College. Please refer to the Southern Vermont College Catalog for more details and a recommended course sequence.

If a student has not completed the ADN program at SRJC and wishes to apply to the ADN program at Southern Vermont College, then the student is required to have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.85 and to have successfully completed Anatomy and Physiology I & II, or their equivalents, to be eligible for consideration and to enroll in the Nursing clinical courses.

A Licensed Practical Nurse transfer student from Santa Rosa Junior College who has not been accepted into the SRJC ADN program can apply for admission to the Southern Vermont College ADN program. LPN students interested in the SVC ADN program are required to take the National League of Nursing Mobility Profile I examinations. The successful completion of the NLN examination will exempt the student from Nursing I for the first semester.

Below are the course requirements for the Associate's Degree in Nursing program at Southern Vermont College, and the Santa Rosa Junior College equivalents, followed by the SVC Bachelor of Science in Nursing requirements and the SRJC equivalents. A student must complete an ADN, either at Southern Vermont College or Santa Rosa Junior College, to be eligible for the BSN program at SVC.
