ASSOCIATE DEGREE GENERAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

Completion of all general education requirements before beginning the Radiologic Technology program is **strongly recommended**.

Please note: Starting in 2015, the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists will require an Associate Degree as eligibility to sit for the licensing examination.

Some program prerequisite courses will also meet General Education Requirements for the Associate Degree. **However, please note that a course may be used only once to fulfill GE Requirements even though it may be approved for more than one GE area. The only exception is Area H (Global Perspectives and Environmental Literacy) which allows a single course to double count in another area of the GE pattern.**

MATH COMPETENCY: Will be met by completing the program math prerequisite (passing a math course listed under Communication and Analytical Thinking, *intermediate algebra or higher level*, with a letter grade of C or better.)
