

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

**SULLIVAN UNIVERSITY
AND
SANTA ROSE JUNIOR COLLEGE**

Sullivan University and Santa Rosa Junior College are committed to working together to create transfer opportunities for Santa Rosa Junior College students that will facilitate the transfer process encouraging more students to reach their education and career goals.

Sullivan University agrees to accept transfer credit from Santa Rosa Junior College for students wishing to pursue the Bachelor of Science in Hospitality Management (BSHM). Transfer credit may apply as follows:

1. Sullivan University will accept as block credit all credits from Santa Rosa Junior College's associate degree in Culinary Arts or Restaurant Management, as permitted by Sullivan's accrediting association, the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools.
2. Students will enter Sullivan University's Bachelor of Science in Hospitality Management at the junior level.

This agreement is designed as a 2+2 program in which students completing an associate degree in Culinary Arts or Restaurant Management from Santa Rosa Junior College may transfer into Sullivan University's Bachelor of Science in Hospitality Management without duplication of course work, pursuant to accrediting criteria. There are BSHM pre-requisites in general education that may require additional coursework at Sullivan University or at another accredited college or university.

Sullivan University will assess and communicate the effectiveness of this agreement to Santa Rosa Junior College with regard to student preparation and student usage. Both parties will review the agreement and assessment data annually.
