Example: If a U.S. History at a CCC is approved for Cal-GETC Area 3B (Humanities), then the U.S. History AP exam may be used for Cal-GETC Area 3B (Humanities, via local articulation) or Area 4 (Social and Behavioral Sciences, via Cal-GETC credit by exam equivalency).

+ Noted Limitations:

Calculus Exams: - Students who complete both the Calc AB and BC Exams will be limited to max equivalency credit for MATH 1A. Students who receive a score of 5 on the Calc BC Exam must submit a Course Substitution form to the Department for approval to also receive equivalency credit for MATH 1B; CSU Limitation: Max one Calculus exam toward transfer; UC Limitation: Max 8 q/5.3s units for both. Students who receive a score of 5 on the Calculus BC Exam must consult SRJC Math Department Chair for Consideration of Math 1B Equivalency.

Economics Exams: Max Credit One Economics course (3 units)

English Exams: SRJC Limitations: Duplicate units not awarded for ENGL 1A if both AP English Exams successfully completed; Units reflected ENGL 1A (4) and ENGL 1B (3), 7 units total for both exams. UC Limitations: Transfer Units 8q/5.3s max for both exams.

U.S. Govt and Politics: CSU Limitation: Does not fulfill US-3 State and Local Government for CSU Graduation Requirement. Students can satisfy after transfer

Physics Exams: SRJC Limitation: Max credit 4 units in Physics; CSU Limitation: Max 4 semester units for GE & 6 semester units towards transfer; UC Limitation: Max 8 qrtr/5.3 semester units for all exams. A successful score on both Physics C- Mechanics and Physics C- Electricity and Magnetism is required to earn credit for PHYS 11

When included within the Associate Degree for Transfer (AA-T/AS-T), College-Level Examination Program (CLEP) credit shall apply toward the lower-division minimum unit requirement for the CSU degree, and if applicable, the minimum unit designation for the CSU major or CSU GE-Breadth requirements.

UC: The University of California **does not** accept CLEP credit. **IGETC:** CLEP **cannot** be used on IGETC. **Cal-GETC:** CLEP **cannot** be used on Cal-GETC.
