

## Santa Rosa Junior College Credit for Advanced Placement

### Important Notes for Students and Counselors:

- Students must have the College Board send official Advanced Placement (AP) Exam results to the Office of Admissions, Records, & Enrollment Development for evaluation. Students must submit a Transfer Credit Evaluation Form.
- Credit may be applied to General Education and/or SRJC Associate Degrees, Associate Degrees for Transfer, or Certificates.
- Students who receive AP credit and then take the comparable SRJC course will have the unit credit for such duplication deducted
- Course credit and units granted at SRJC may differ from transfer institutions. Each university determines how exams will apply toward credit in a major. Please consult with a counselor for assistance in clarifying university policy. Even the transfer units listed below for CSU/UC can vary, it is important to verify policy with your chosen transfer campus
- Credit may be earned for College Entrance Examination Board (CEEB) for AP Exams with a minimum score of 3. Some departments require a score higher than 3 or place conditions on the award of credit as indicated in the chart below. For exams with higher score requirements, a score of 3 will still earn the student SRJC elective units and GE Area Credit and units as indicated below.
- **For all Associate Degrees for Transfer (ADT) a score of 3 or higher is acceptable for use of credit for a comparable course in the ADT major. Students must be advised, however, that should they not pursue the ADT, the department score requirement is still in place for prerequisite clearance or other Non-ADT Majors and Certificate Programs. Please consult your Counselor or contact Evaluations for clarification. \*AP Exams are indicated below where this policy would apply.**
